### **Holiday recycling and waste tips for Briny Breezes residents**

Many food and drink containers can be recycled in the Blue recycling bins, including:

- \* Plastic bottles and containers, except foam cups
- \* Aluminum, tin and steel cans
- \* Cartons, such as those for milk, juice boxes, chicken broth, etc.
- \* Glass bottles and jars

Boating & Fishing volunteers pick up newspaper and all fiber, including the following. Please be sure all boxes are flattened and tied/taped together.

- \* Flattened cardboard boxes, including gift boxes
- \* Greeting cards and wrapping paper that have no ribbons, foil or other non-paper items
- \* Paperboard food boxes, cereal boxes and paper towel rolls
- \* Newspaper, office paper, junk mail, paperback books, magazines, etc.

Thank you for not placing these items in recycling:

- \* Plastic bags, film or shrink wrap (they damage recycling equipment)
- \* Gift bags, tissue paper, ribbons or bows
- \* Disposable plates and silverware
- \* Grease stained pizza boxes (throw those in the trash, but clean pizza boxes can go in with paper and other boxes)
- \* Napkins or paper towels
- \* Drink pouches
- \* Holiday lights
