SIGN UP FOR EMERGENCY ALERTS

Police Captain Christopher Yannuzzi announced at the Town Council meeting that residents can sign up to receive emergency alerts specific to Briny Breezes by using the web site www.readypbc.org. Once on that web site, it will allow anyone to create an account and choose to be contacted by text message, mobile phone, home phone, or email. A user can also select which alerts to receive, for example, hurricane watch, hurricane warning, tornado watch, tornado warning, thunderstorms, and/or floods, etc. Town Council and the Corporate Office encourage all residents to sign up so that they are notified immediately of any severe weather or emergency situations.

MANAGER NEWS

BULLPEN/RV INCREASE

At our last board meeting, April 12, 2017, it was decided to increase the rates of the Bullpen, effective immediately. \$30 per day (+ tax) for stockholders and \$60 per day (+ tax) for non-residents. A 3 day deposit will be required in advance, when you reserve. This deposit will be NON-REFUNDABLE. Thank you for your cooperation.

MARINA INCREASE

It was also decided at 4/12/17 meeting to increase Marina slip rentals, effective 10/1/2017, 5% for non stockholders.

GOLF CART & CAR STORAGE: If you are storing your golf cart and/or car this summer, we must have current insurance and the storage lease agreement filled out. You can pick up one of the agreement forms in the office. Thank you. ***BE SURE WE HAVE YOUR CURRENT GOLF CART INSURANCE ON RECORD (FOR ALL RESIDENTS WITH CARTS – EVEN IF YOU AREN'T STORING IT.)**

EVERYONE should have their unit number visible on their mobile home. It should be reflective so that it can be seen at night, in case of emergencies.

EMERGENCY CONTACT FORMS: Before you leave for the season, please make sure you've filled out a contact form. Many of you have already done this last season; if you have, you don't need to do it again unless the contact info has changed. If you do need a new form, they are available in the office. Thank you.

911 & NON EMERGENCY CALLS: YOU MUST PROVIDE THE FULL STREET ADDRESS of the location of the issue, NOT the mailing address (5000 N Ocean Blvd) or their Unit letter/number. This will improve the response time of both Police and Fire/EMS. Thank you! * Also, the non-emergency number for Boynton Beach is (561) 732-8116.

REMINDER: All pets must be on a leash and fully under the control of its owner while in our community. District V, while currently vacant, is not a dog park. We have folks that still walk in the area. And as always, please pick up after your dog, even in our garden areas.

SMOKE ALARMS: It is imperative that you check the batteries in your smoke alarm and make sure it is in good working order. There was an incident where one went off in Briny and it may have saved that mobile home or even a person! Check your batteries!

TELEPHONE NUMBERS: We are putting together a 'phone blast' for emergencies. If you have a new cell number that we don't have, please let the office know. Thank you.
