#### RULE OF THE WEEK: Rule C. 2 Rentals

Application Process – The following information must be received at least 30 days prior to occupancy so there is adequate time to review and approve applications. If a renter arrives in Briny Breezes and the Corporation has not received the following items, there will be a penalty to the Owner in accordance with the Violation and Fining Process in Appendix I.

- a. Owners Application to Rent completed by the owner (current application copies from previous years will NOT be accepted).
- b. Rental Application completed by the renter this should be returned to owner and submitted with the rental package (current application copies from previous years will NOT be accepted).
- c. Administration Fee at current rates payable to Briny Breezes, Inc.
- d. Copy of the signed lease agreement including dates (a minimum of two months maximum nine months. No rentals July September)
- e. List of provided items on the Recommended Furnishings checklist signed by Owner.
- f. First-time renter(s) must pay for criminal background check(s) prior to application approval.
- g. A parking decal deposit at current rates, refundable upon return of decal

**MORE BBC-8 NEWS** Some of the BBC-8 volunteers visited the Key Biscayne community television studio last month to get a few ideas on how to improve our own station. One of the interesting things we found out was that their station looked just like ours did about 3 years ago. Large metal racks, rows of outdated equipment and miles of cable. They reorganized, acquired some new equipment and implemented some new programs and currently have a very organized, effective, state-of-the-art television studio, providing content for the entire Key Biscayne community. Another thing we found interesting was that Key Biscayne also has ATT U-verse as one of their providers. Consequently, they suffer from the same sub-par quality picture and sound that we sometimes experience. We were sort of relived that it is an ATT issue and not something that BBC-8 (or Key Biscayne) can remedy or control, at this time. BBC-8 hopes to get more people involved with the studio. Next season BBC-8 will invite members to visit the studio and control room on a regular basis, to learn the equipment, talk to the engineers and anchors and feel comfortable in and around a television studio. Workshops, trainings and mock programming will all be part of the community involvement that we hope BBC-8 will offer next season. ## **TOWN NEWS SIGN UP FOR EMERGENCY ALERTS**

Police Captain Christopher Yannuzzi announced at the Town Council meeting that residents can sign up to receive emergency alerts specific to Briny Breezes by using the web site <a href="www.readypbc.org">www.readypbc.org</a>. Once on that web site, it will allow anyone to create an account and choose to be contacted by text message, mobile phone, home phone, or email. A user can also select which alerts to receive, for example, hurricane watch, hurricane warning, tornado watch, tornado warning, thunderstorms, and/or floods, etc. Town Council and the Corporate Office encourage all residents to sign up so that they are notified immediately of any severe weather or emergency situations.
