## **RULE REMINDER: B. Occupancy/Lots and Looks**

**2. Pets (Birds, Dogs and Cats)** – In pet sections only, as defined by Section 3.40 of the By-Laws, one pet only is permitted per residence. At no time are pets permitted in corporate buildings, on the beach, in the pool area, in the overnight parking area, or in the restricted sections other than roadways.

Pets must be kept on an attended leash no longer than 15 feet at all times when outside the mobile home. Let them commit no nuisance to the annoyance of the neighbors.

Pet owners must arrange for the immediate collection of wastes created by their pet and return such waste to their own property for disposal. A resident who has a medical need for a pet as defined under the federal Fair Housing Disability laws must present applicable documentation showing that such need is appropriate and in compliance with those laws.

## **MANAGER NEWS**

**AT&T VACATION MODE – IMPORTANT:** Vacation Hold can be activated for a minimum period of two months and a maximum period of nine months.

When you voluntarily suspend your services, you are not able to suspend one service or reinstate only one service, it is all or nothing. **If you only have basic TV service that the Briny Breezes Bulk provides, you do not have to suspend.** If you are suspending your services you will be charged \$5.00 recurring monthly fee per service. When you reinstate the services you will be refunded for your Briny bulk TV only.

You must call the Bulk Center to reinstate or suspend services: 1-866-299-6824.

When calling you will need your 9 digit account number. The Bulk Center is open 8am -8pm, closed on weekends. If you call on the weekends it will forward you to a regular customer service department. They are not the correct department to handle your request. Please call the Bulk Center Number listed above Monday-Friday.

**OCH PORCH WORK:** Work has begun and will continue (weather permitting) on the Ocean Clubhouse porch. Sections will be closed off. It will be approximately a 2 week process.
