DEAR BRINY & POCKET RESIDENTS There were about 100 residents from our 2 communities at a 11/13/18 clubhouse meeting about the Gulf Stream Views project under construction between Briny Breezes Blvd. & Seaview Rd.

The trailers on Briny Breezes Blvd & the homes in the pocket are only a few feet above road level, so will likely bear the full force of cascading flood waters or storm surges which will flow on each side of the new "concrete mountain" & could cause significant flood damage or destruction of our homes.

We have consulted experts, who are willing to give us a break on the cost of evaluating the plan for adequacy, a 2nd objective opinion &/or making suggestions to the County to change them.

We need to raise money for their work estimated to be \$3,000. Briny's share would be \$1000. We will be aiming for \$100 per unit owner, & will be contacting you for whatever help you can give--\$ or time to prevent feared destruction of Briny. We hope for your support, individual & community, corporation & town. We have had successful fund raisers, so please share your ideas for that.
