MOBILE HOME TIE DOWN PROGRAM

Lawn Watering Restrictions April is Water Conservation Month and a good time for this reminder. Lawn watering is limited all year in Briny Breezes and South Florida by the South Florida Water Management District's Year-Round Landscape Irrigation Rule. If you have an automatic sprinkler or irrigation system, please be sure it is set according to the following SFWMD rules.
If your unit number ends in 1,3,5,7, or 9 – water on Monday, Wednesday, or Saturday.
If your unit number ends in 2,4,6,8, or 0 – water on Tuesday, Thursday, or Sunday.
No watering is allowed from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and not at all on Fridays.

Also please remember Briny Breezes' corporate rule B.6:

WATERING – Watering of lawns and shrubs and other water usage is regulated by local government authorities and any special restrictions imposed must be complied with. Any connected type of irrigation or watering system must have a timer and a rain sensor installed. The system and timer must be set to comply with South Florida Water Management District restrictions. The stockholder must have a person registered with the Office to oversee the system if the unit is unoccupied. Non-compliance with this rule will result in the water being turned off.

HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

Chicago Tribune – January 2, 1937 'Briny Breezes by the Sea for Trailers & Campers'

This 'anchorage for trailers and campers' offers advantage of former million dollar subdivision of forty acres. There are hundreds of yards of coral sand beach; groves of stately Coconut palm and Australian pine; splendid water systematically piped to all parts; pavements, sidewalks, electricity; flush toilets, shower baths, laundry, hot and cold water.

Shaded grassy camp sites of generous space offer quiet away from main highway; lulled by sea breakers, among murmuring pines. Bathe and fish; watch the sea and air liners sail by; enjoy the bracing balmy air; suntan in the sands or loll in the shade. This is one of the many trailer towns that have sprung up in Florida in the last two years. Families from the north are living there, paying \$3 a week to rent. It is 18 miles south of fashionable Palm Beach where the rich pay \$10-\$25 a day hotel rent to enjoy the same sunshine and surf. School bus stops at camp.

BEFORE LEAVING BRINY FOR THE SUMMER Please make sure to secure your home properly for hurricane season (June 1 to November 30). All patio furniture, bicycles, BBQ's, hanging items, trash cans, hoses and any miscellaneous items must be removed from the outside of units. It is not recommended to store BBQ propane tanks in or under your units. If you have a shed or Large LP gas tanks, they must be tied down securely.

Plants and Bushes: Stockholders are responsible for keeping their plants trimmed and areas weeded during the summer. All plants must be trimmed back away from the streets. Before you leave, please make arrangements to have someone take care of your landscaping. Give the name and contact information of this person. If you do not have someone and we are forced to maintain your yard you will receive an invoice from Briny.

STEPS TO CLOSING MOBILE HOMES (Take pictures of your home and contents)

- 1) Forward mail and suspend newspaper delivery.
- 2) Give keys to your caretaker and the Briny Office. Give the office the caretakers name and contact information.
- 3) Fill out emergency contact information form and return to the Briny Office, notify the office when you are leaving.
- 4) Take one Briny ID Badge with you for re-entering Briny after hurricanes.
- 5) Replace air-conditioning filters, turn off hot water switch and breaker / drain hot water heater tank.
- 6) Empty food from the refrigerator/freezer, block the door open or leave running with water only inside and put vegetable oil in garbage disposal.
- 7) Put RV antifreeze in bottom of dishwasher, washing machine and all drains.
- 8) Disconnect cable and electric from TV's and unplug all electrical items except refrigerator if left running. Disconnect telephone and answering machine and remove batteries.
- 9) Set humidistat and thermostat - turn off electric breakers except for A/C (to prevent mold or mildew)
- 10) Put out new roach pills and powder under cabinets and drawers. Put out ant traps in kitchen.
- 11) Set out pans of kitty litter and charcoal.
- 12) Cover toilet and toilet tank with Saran Wrap to seal and clean out garbage can and place inside.
- 13) Remove batteries from TV remote, flashlights, calculator, radio.
- 14) Remove address books, phone books, cameras and important papers • Open all closet doors and drawers / leave clothes dryer sheets in all rooms.
- 15) Trim all bushes back - remove all seasonal flowers. Give the office a name for our yard person and contact number.
- 16) Turn off water to mobile home. Disconnect and put water hose and reel inside mobile.
- 17) Clean grill and place inside mobile home, clean rain gutters and check roof for leaks.
- 18) Anchor outside storage shed (use straps over top and around the shed). Put outside chairs inside mobile home, put flower pots under mobile home.

Remove all loose items and place inside home (if two strong men can't lift it - leave it)
Install and lower hurricane shutters, lock all doors **3/25/2019 DC**
