### **IMPROVING OUR CURB APPEAL**

An AMAZING Weekend for Briny! Twenty-Six (26) volunteers showed both Fri. and Saturday morning to perform a labor of love for our community.

1) Fence Painting - All 325 feet of the North Beach Park fence received a new coat of white paint. 12 Brinyites / 5 gallons later / 36 man hours of labor. It may not be professional BUT it looks Great and we had a lot of fun working together.

2) Shrubs Pruning & Weeding - All East facing hedges were pruned and surrounding ground base was weeded. Most Impressive - North OCH planter wall received a long overdue cleaning, pruning of the “cardboard palms”, and removal of ugly red lava rocks. Thanks to 9 volunteers.

3) Sea Grape Shade Canopy - Work continued on North property line. Last month invasive plants and decades of trash were removed from the North park wall. The Silver Button Wood trees were trimmed high and this weekend work continued on the Sea Grape trees along the North dune. Already you can witness the beauty of the cleared Invasives and the cooling effect of the tree canopy.

4) Dune Preservation Ropes - in our continued attempt to control the sand drift and protect our dune plants four residents worked until we ran out of supplies. They dug post holes, installed posts and strung attractive natural ropes down 3 of our 5 beach paths. They also installed a low rope in front of the porch. Hopefully this will stop people from crossing over the wall and trampling the dune flowers.

**TRAVEL CLUB** February Travel Program a Hit. A program of bird photography captivated an enthusiastic crowd at the February meeting of the Travel Club. Photographers Andy Neurether and Jim Carter highlighted the changes in bird populations and photographic techniques since their last presentation in 2016. Jim explained how the increase in woodstork populations and the commensurate decrease in Great Blue Herons has changed nesting patterns of these birds particularly at Wakodahatchie Wet Lands. Andy noted that "cameras in your pocket" are powerful and capable of excellent bird pictures. Several photos in the program were taken with i phones. The March Travel Club meeting will feature the annual potluck supper followed by a program on Tanzania 2017 by Linda Sudds.
