**PARK IMPROVEMENTS – LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE** In a continuing effort to offer residents a more enjoyable park like environment we want to point out two major improvements for you to visit in Briny.

\* First is our North Beach Park Wall. L&B succeeded in reshaping this previously unsightly and overgrown area on our north wall. FL DEP Class 1 invasive plants have been removed along with years of trash. The Silver Buttonwood trees have been trimmed high to provide cooling shade and allow sight through and under new plantings along the white wall.

\*\* Second is the “Secret Garden” improvements made to the Laundry/Pool Cabana area. Both Queen Palms died and have been replaced with Montgomery Palms that do not require expensive trimming. The aged shrubs could not be saved and have been replaced with new “Sloppy Painter” Crotons which pick up the yellow of the surrounding buildings on green leaves. Plans include additional coloring through shrubs and flowers. A Bench has been added to a new paver platform, but most notable is the artistic bronze sculpture of a little girl and a fairy. Thank You should be directed to Keith Black of district 1 for providing this beautiful centerpiece.

Both improvements are “Works in Progress” with a plan for additional improvements. Things move slowly as most of our improvements are provided by volunteers - and as we age we seem to move a lot slower. Both projects were initiated by resident suggestions to L&B Committee. Your patience is appreciated as we make visual improvements one step at a time.

### **Bit of Briny**

October 15, 1959 Bugle: Briny Breezes Fishing Club – First meeting in the West Club House to elect officers, Tuesday, November 3. Membership fee, \$2.00 – ladies welcome. Regular weekly meeting, guest, speakers, fishing trips, contests, prizes, companionship, fun, graduate course in lying, post graduate course in prevarication. Founding fathers: Charles Haller, Sam Levitt, Peter Kolean

January 19, 1977 – throughout Palm Beach, Broward and Dade counties, millions were awed by the spectacle of snow that visited South Florida for the first time on record ahead of a Siberia cold blast that iced roads in the Panhandle. Schools were closed and crops were ruined all the way to Homestead. Temperatures were in the 20's and \$91 million worth of fruits and vegetables were destroyed.
