TOWN NEWS

HIRING A HOME CAREGIVER

The Board of County Commissioners recently approved changes to the county's Home Caregiver Ordinance. Currently, Palm Beach County is the only county in Florida with a protective ordinance of this type.

The ordinance requires caregivers undergo a level 2 criminal background check. Once processed, and if no disqualifying offenses are identified, applicants are issued a photo ID. Anyone engaging the services of a home caregiver is urged to verify credentials both in person and online. Residents can verify that a caregiver has a valid ID badge by visiting www.pbcgov.com/consumer.

CENSUS 2020 The U.S. Census counts each and every resident in the nation, including right here in Briny Breezes. The collected data helps to determine things like the number of seats Florida has in the House of Representatives, and how to distribute federal funds to local communities like ours. The Census is closer than you think and it's essential that everyone in Briny Breezes be counted.

Article I, Section 2 of the U.S. Constitution mandates that a census occur every 10 years, and it's happening next spring in 2020. The information the census collects helps determine how more than \$675 billion of federal funding is distributed to states and communities each year.

If you had projects done at your unit this season, please be sure to close out your permit(s) by having the final inspection completed and signed off. If the final inspection is not done promptly, your permit may expire while you are not here, which then requires a \$100 renewal fee when you return. If you are not sure if your permit is closed, please call Maya at Town Hall, 561-272-5495.
