**GREENSHEET IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE**

The Briny Breezes “Greensheet Improvement Committee” is in the process of recommending changes to the Greensheet to (1) simplify and clarify the language, (2) update its rules and restrictions for changes to the state Building Code and Town Ordinances and (3) to consider changes to District setbacks. The suggested improvements to the Greensheet (Appendix 2 of the Rules) will be presented to Briny Board of Directors in mid-December at a Special Meeting of the Board. We recommend that all stockholders review this document paying particular attention to any changes that may affect their District.

The Committee will be posting the current version of its proposed changes to the Greensheet on the Briny web site. We hope that stockholders will take the time to make the Committee or their Directors aware of any suggestions and/or concerns that they may have with these recommendations in time for the Committee to fully consider the input before submitting its final version to the Board.

**OPENINGS FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS IN DISTRICTS 1, 2 & 3**
