TO HOMEOWNERS

RE: Mold...Mold is appearing on many of the buildings in Briny. A high pressure hose does not kill the mold/fungus. It clears it off the visible areas, but forces it up into the overlapped areas of the units. A better and easier way is a pump sprayer, filled 1/3 with bleach, 2/3 water, and some laundry detergent. It kills off the mold on the outside of the buildings, and seeps somewhat inside the overlap siding to kill the non visible mold. ~ Bruce Jensen (V-203)
