#### **TOWN NEWS**

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR TOWN OF BRINY BREEZES: There is an opening on the Town Council for an Alderman to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Karen Wiggins from the Council. The Town Council has five aldermen and the mayor and meets every month year-round on the fourth Thursday of each month. Town Council members are required by law to be registered voters in the Town of Briny Breezes, but do not need to be homesteaded. Council members should be able to be present at meetings year-round, for the most part.

There is also an opening to fill a long-standing vacancy from District 4 on our P&Z board. The P&Z Board does not meet regularly every month because the Town's biggest recent task, amending the Comprehensive Plan, was completed almost two years ago. The P&Z board will have the occasional special meeting if required for a specific topic such as parking or water planning. The only requirement for this P&Z board member is to be either a District 4 shareholder in Briny Breezes Inc. or a resident of District 4. Volunteers do not need to live here full time or be homesteaded and do not have to be registered to vote in Briny Breezes.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE - SELLING OR RENTING YOUR UNIT

Be sure to use the NEW FORMS if you are selling or renting your unit. Forms were revised in April and have "2015" at the bottom. They should be used from now on. Discard any forms that do not say "2015" at the bottom. The forms are available at www.BrinyBreezes.us or at the Briny Breezes office. Users of www.BrinyBreezes.us will notice that there are separate links now to the forms that an owner has to fill out to rent a unit and to the forms that a renter has to fill out and send to the owner. This was done to make it easier for owners and renters in two Geographic separate places to easily get the forms they need. Once an owner has filled out the owner forms and received the renter forms from the renter, the complete set of forms can be sent to the Briny Breezes office.

Last but not least, please remember all forms must be correctly completed and turned in 30 days prior to the date of the renter arriving and the lease beginning. The Sales and Rentals Committee meets monthly and will review all applications completed in the prior 30 days for Rentals or Sales.

**HOBBY CLUB CLOSING:** The Hobby Club will be closed the last two weeks in August to paint the floor. Thank you.

**OFFICE WALKWAY/SIDEWALK:** Beginning August 3<sup>rd</sup> and continuing for at least a week, the concrete sidewalk at the front office/pharmacy area will be grinded, cemented and painted. Please take precautions if you need to, with the dust and smells that may occur while this is happening.

**PIPE LINING:** Bamboo Dr., Cedar Dr., Ruthmary Ave., and Briny Breezes Blvd. will be under construction August 3<sup>rd</sup> for approx. 4 days in order to work on the storm drains. Bamboo and Cedar Dr. will be CLOSED DOWN 4-5 hours periodically during this project as they proceed from catch basin to catch basin. The areas of work will change from day to day, and throughout the day, as they proceed. We understand time is of the essence and will work to keep the closures to the minimal amount of time possible.

MARINA FENCE: The fence along Banyan at the Marina has been taken down. CAUTION!!!!

SEAWALL: Ongoing seawall work will be taking place on Bay Dr. during the month of August.

AT & T: Work will be happening throughout the park (at the outside of units) throughout the summer. #### PRESIDENTS LETTER

Dear Shareholders,

I hope this bugle finds you and your families doing well. Briny is doing well. The sun is shining, the sea turtles are laying their eggs and we are roasting in the hot Florida sun. Our long list of summer projects is progressing along, beautiful updates taking place around the park and key improvements are being made to some of our oldest infrastructure. Did you know that we have terracotta pipes used for drainage? Yes like a flower pot. This was common practice from the 1880s until the 1970s. Most cities, towns and builders stopped using them in the 60's because of how susceptible they were to cracking and being penetrated by tree roots. Our terracotta pipes are in need of some serious repairs and are the cause of drainage/flow issues, mainly in District 1. We fix this by lining the existing pipes, prior to breakage. Why am I telling you this? Well this is a big project that we are working on and hoping that this "solution" makes a significant difference in water drainage on Briny Breezes Blvd and through other areas of District 1 and 2. There are a number of other "drainage" projects going on including addition of pumps to move water along more efficiently and of course the RAISING of the seawall cap on the East and South sides of the marina. YES this is happening and as of last week, FAST. Our contractor is moving full steam ahead and we hope that this project is a success in controlling some of the flooding in District 3 (south).

3 of our bathhouse roofs were completely re-done, the auditorium roof is complete and the clubhouse roof has been cleaned, caulked and sealed a beautiful and shiny white.

New hurricane windows and one set of doors have been installed in the clubhouse (kitchen end, east side.) They are basically maintenance free, beautiful, energy efficient and withstand hurricane force winds.

It would be a HUGE improvement to complete ALL of the additional windows and doors in the clubhouse, a big project that we may be able to tackle next summer.

The pharmacy and corporate office windows have also been completed (yes the broken pharmacy windows are finally gone) and the exterior paint has been touched up to look great.

AT&T is busy with their preparations to bring Briny on board; and we have a 3<sup>rd</sup> party contractor all lined up to Briny BBC8 on too, so no worries there! You will be getting additional information about getting your unit hooked into AT&T in the coming weeks.

The maintenance staff is working extra hard, even in this sweltering heat to get our park ready for the upcoming season. Your office staff is working to further enhance the efficiency of the office, records and dealings with corporate business and Theresa is doing a wonderful job overseeing this progression.

I wish all of you a wonderful AUGUST! Onward and forward we go!
