HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE – BITS OF BRINY HISTORY

January 1967 – Our swimming pool is 30 years old this year. Therefore it is fitting that we review a bit of the work that was necessary to encourage stockholders to vote in favor of this facility. This letter, composed by Dr. Charles Prudhon, was mailed to each and every stockholder with help from members of the Swim Club paid for from the Swim Club treasury.

'What Every Briny Member Should Know about the Swimming Pool Proposal' – In the February 22 election you will have an opportunity to vote on releasing money from the Restricted Improvement Fund to the construction of a swimming pool. This is in accordance with the wishes expressed by 76% of the 240 resident owners, representing all districts, who were questioned in a recent survey. Who would benefit? Everyone who likes to swim, of course, will enjoy the pool, especially when the sea is too rough or too cold for comfort, and when the man-o-war blow in – and when the tide is out and the rocks are a menace on the beach. Heart patients and people suffering from circulation ailments, high blood pressure, arthritis and muscle soreness will appreciate the benefits of the jet spray which will be a feature of the pool. This is a new development and highly endorsed by the Medical Association. And everyone who owns stock will find that his lots are worth more when we modernize with a pool. It will also help us retain our 5 star rating and make us more attractive to the class of people we'd like in Briny.

Replacement gates for the beach access on the south side have been ordered and we are hopeful that once installed, will stop some of the NON-SHAREHOLDER traffic. Our road drainage and seawall projects are still in the final planning stages and hopefully will commence soon.

We are in the final stages of our cable contract negotiations with AT&T, hopefully we will have an agreement signed very soon so that work transitioning the park over can commence immediately. We are also installing new rip-tide safety signs at all of our entrances to the beach.

We also recently purchased a great new BBQ Grill for the pool cabana that is already getting lots of use.

Please note that police ARE TICKETING expired parking decals. Residents who still have a dark blue parking decal on their car need to remove it and get the current light blue parking decal from the management office. Renters should have a current maroon parking decal.

IMPORTANT NOTICE – SELLING OR RENTING YOUR UNIT

Be sure to use the NEW FORMS if you are selling or renting your unit. Forms were revised in April and have “2015” at the bottom. They should be used from now on.

Discard any forms that do not say “2015” at the bottom. The forms are available at www.BrinyBreezes.us or at the Briny Breezes office. Users of www.BrinyBreezes.us will notice that there are separate links now to the forms that an owner has to fill out to rent a unit and to the forms that a renter has to fill out and send to the owner. This was done to make it easier for owners and renters in two Geographic separate places to easily get the forms they need. Once an owner has filled out the owner forms and received the renter forms from the renter, the complete set of forms can be sent to the Briny Breezes office.

Last but not least, please remember all forms must be correctly completed and turned in 30 days prior to the date of the renter arriving and the lease beginning. The Sales and Rentals Committee meets monthly and will review all applications completed in the prior 30 days for Rentals or Sales.
