SALUTING VETERANS – 11/11/16 – OCEAN CLUBHOUSE

In November 1919, one year after the armistice ending World War I went into effect, President Woodrow Wilson declared Nov. 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day with the following words: To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations. ...

In 1938, Congress approved a bill that made Nov. 11 an annual legal holiday known as "Armistice Day" that would honor the cause of world peace. In 1954, after World War II, the law was amended, the word "Armistice" was changed to "Veterans" and Nov. 11 became a day to honor veterans of all American wars.

Excerpts from 1969 Briny Brochure

Activities never cease at Briny – always busy, always occupied are the Auditorium, the twin clubhouses, the fresh water heated swimming pool, the 14 outdoor shuffleboard courts, the hobby shop, the art building, the yacht basin and the magnificent sparkling sands of the cool inviting surf along the 630 feet of private beach.

There are 511 mobile home spaces in the park 'owned' (leased is the proper term) by club members. Some members have more than one space and these are occasionally available for rental on a yearly basis. For particulars regarding the rental and sale of spaces, communicate with the Briny Breezes office. A centrally located group of twenty four corporation lots are also available for rental on an annual basis. All sales and rentals are subject to the approval of the Club Membership Committee.

Briny Breezes Club has within its limits various businesses to serve you: Grocery Store, Laundry, Restaurant & Cocktail Lounge, Awning Mfg. Co., Prescription Pharmacy, Beauty Shop, Barber Shop.

PAINT YOUR HOME WITH FREE RECYCLED PAINT

Each year, the Solid Waste Authority of Palm Beach County provides thousands of gallons of recycled paint to residents in need of updating the exterior of their homes.

Residents of Palm Beach County can get a one-time donation of free, high-quality exterior latex house paint. To qualify for a one-time paint donation, recipients must:

- Reside in Palm Beach County
- Be single-family homeowners only
- Occupy the home they own
- Have a home up to 3,000 square feet

For help applying for the free paint, stop by Town Hall near the beauty shop or call 272-5495. If approved, paint will be available in four to six weeks. Applicants will be contacted by Solid Waste Authority when their paint is available. Palm Beach County residents who have old paint to dispose of may visit any of the Solid Waste Authority of Palm Beach County's seven Home Chemical and Recycling Centers (<http://www.swa.org/hcrc>) and drop it off for free. There are seven convenient county locations for residents to drop off their home chemicals; the 2 closest to Briny Breezes are:

- Central County Transfer Station, 1810 Lantana Road in Lantana
- South County Transfer Station, 1901 SW 4th Ave. in Delray Beach

Each year, the SWA recycles more than 120,000 lbs. of latex paint, and safely disposes of more than 1 million pounds of household hazardous waste.

TOWN OF BRINY BREEZES NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town Council will hold a 2nd public hearing on November 17, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. at the Briny Breezes Town Hall, 4802 North Ocean Boulevard. At that time, the Town Council will consider a one-year moratorium on the cultivation, dispensing, or processing of medical marijuana within the Town. Such a moratorium would not affect the use of medical marijuana as prescribed by a physician. Interested residents are encouraged to attend.

MANAGER NEWS

911 & NON EMERGENCY CALLS: When calling 9-1-1 or the non/emergency number, YOU MUST PROVIDE THE FULL STREET ADDRESS of the location of the issue, NOT the mailing address (5000 N Ocean Blvd) or their Unit letter/number. This will improve the response time of both Police and Fire/EMS. Thank you!

AT & T: Please remember to call (866)299-6824, which is the Bulk number, for any billing inquiries, changes to account or to add new services. Thank you.

RESIDENTS WHO HAVE ALARM SYSTEMS: Boynton Beach Communications does not monitor alarms. Anyone who may have been monitored by Ocean Ridge PD will have to hire a monitoring company. In addition, any residents or businesses that have alarm systems, will need to obtain a City of Boynton Beach Alarm Permit. This is a one-time \$30 fee. Keep in mind, since the Boynton Beach Fire/Rescue Department has been providing service for many years, many may already have a Boynton Beach permit, so there will be no change. The single permit covers burglar, fire, and/or medical alarms. Documents are available in the Briny office.

MAIL: Please remember that when mail is ready, the outside light will be on. The light informs you that mail is sorted and is ready for pickup. Go to the mailroom window to retrieve packages.
