TURF & WEED Control around your UNIT

Our Maintenance personnel is instructed to cut and trim the turf areas in and around each unit up to the skirting or to the hard/durable edge. IF the owner of a property is concerned about the trimming of turf where the structure or skirting may be damaged by reasonable use of string trimmers by the Landscaper, the Owner shall provide a form of durable surface for trimmers to work up to, or at the their option the owners will be responsible for maintaining the trimming around their own unit.

‘Briny Breezes Breaks Out to Celebrate Expansion’ – *PB Post December 1967*

Briny is on the move, the signs read and they proved it. Almost two dozen groups paraded across A1A and down to a grandstand set up in the middle of the mobile home community to dedicate the town’s new swimming pool and remodeled recreation building. ‘It’s the biggest progress we’ve made in one year, so we thought we’d throw everybody into the act.’ ‘Everybody’ included a Florida type Santa Claus clad in swim trunks and riding a motor scooter, fishermen carrying fresh caught fish off Briny’s beach, and a half dozen convict-garbed denizens of ‘Alcatraz’, the small rental section of the community.

The Seacrest High School band highlighted the cavalcade and representatives of the shuffleboard, cycling, hobby, card, trailer travel, wood workers, billiard and boat clubs paraded behind. The clubs put on skits in front of the residents, numbering slightly under 1,000 and from the enthusiasm of the players and audience, it was easy to see why ‘Briny is on the move’. ~ Submitted by Dorothy McNeice

PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Well the summer is over, it flew by too fast. Briny was extremely busy at work, there was no "summer slowdown" and now we are all keeping a close eye on the tropics and hopeful that all these "disturbances" keep out of our paradise. I missed adding a note to you the last few bugles so for those of you not in Briny, we have a lot of catching up to do. Infrastructure upgrades have continued all summer with the finishing of the marina, underground pipe upgrades, replacements and linings, catch basin additions and new pumps being added to push water out of our way faster helping us to further mitigate the effects of flooding and rising tides. As you know, we cannot stop the water, but we are working hard to get this water out of the streets and away from units more quickly and more effectively. Now that all of this work is done, bay drive will be repaved. Hopefully this will give us a "model" to use for future re-paving as some of our other roads are getting pretty broken up.

Upgrades are being made to the office as we needed to remove deteriorating ceiling tiles and bad/moldy insulation that was causing respiratory problems for the office staff. With that we are making some upgrades to lighting (LED) for better energy efficiency and also modified the layout for more functional efficiency. Upgrades are being made to the office air conditioning and deteriorating duct work and also replacements are being made to units in the auditorium and as of this week, it looks like the clubhouse will need new units too. A new card reader system is being installed and has been a huge undertaking for staff. Your new cards will properly open the laundry room front and rear, community center and the clubhouse front, rear and bathrooms too. This new system can be added to in the future so maybe next year your cards will open the mail room and other places too.

This last week we saw the auditorium get a fresh coat of paint, for the first time in many years, it is 1 consistent blue color all around. I am sure you noticed over the years, there were many areas touched up with many colors of blue paint, which is no more. Our guys have also been painting the library/west club room building and this week we were so excited to see the painters complete the repainting of our clubhouse, a fresh blue, beautiful white trim and they are even re-staining the decking. With the new windows and doors, the clubhouse complex looks amazing, something I am sure you will be very proud of! Oh and our men rebuilt the beach showers too. They now look like the ones you see at the public beaches and high-end hotels. Like I mentioned above LOTS GOING ON!

Keeping this property up and running and looking great, along with improving and upgrading is a huge and never ending effort and fortunately we have a very dedicated staff that is working non-stop for the betterment of Briny. Theresa and Omar have done an amazing job managing a record number of projects, improvements and general work!

I am sure I missed a whole bunch, but it's only another month or so before many of you begin to return for the season, so you will see for yourselves, all of the beautiful improvements to our already beautiful park. Enjoy your Labor Day Weekend and Happy September.
