*Another reminder from the Landscape Committee... On behalf of your Board of Directors*

- Each Stockholder is responsible for the **year round (12 month)** maintenance of their individual property.
- The Landscaper will cut and trim the turf lawn areas in and around each unit up to the skirting or to the **hard/durable** edge of plant beds where hedges, flowers, mulch or rocks are present.
- Again they will only trim up to an area where there is a **hard/durable** surface present to trim against.
- Lawn areas between hedges and the Unit Structure will **NOT be maintained by the Landscaper.**
- Weeding of hedge plantings, flower beds and mulched/rocked areas are, of course, the **responsibility of the Owner.**
- If the Owner of a property is concerned about the trimming of turf where the structure or skirting may be damaged by the reasonable use of string trimmers by the Landscaper, the Owner shall provide a form of durable surface for the trimmers to work to or, at their option, **post a Red Driveway Marker indicating that the Owner will complete the required trimming themselves.**

Please remember that **trimming and weeding** conducted by the Owner **needs to be completed regularly, year round,** in conjunction with the Landscaper's normal schedule.

Driveways that are gravel, rocks or spread out paving stones must be kept weed free by the owner, year round. Landscapers cannot be responsible for hand weeding these areas.

We want to keep Briny looking great, 12 months of every year, not just during high season. Please understand that year round maintenance of your unit/grounds is part of the rules that everyone must follow. Let's keep Briny looking Beautiful.

***Fines may be levied upon stockholders who fail to maintain their properties in proper, year round, conditions.***

**IMPORTANT NOTE – SELLING OR RENTING YOUR UNIT**

Be sure to note that there are revised forms in the office and on the web site to be used when selling or renting your unit. The new forms have "2015" at the bottom and should be used from now on. If you have already picked up forms from the office that do not say "2015" at the bottom, be sure to get them completed and turned in to the office before May 31st. The old forms can be used until that date, but after May 31st the revised forms must be used.

The forms have been revised to make them clearer and easier to use, based on feedback from owners and renters. Users of [www.BrinyBreezes.us](http://www.BrinyBreezes.us) will notice that there are separate links now to the forms that an owner has to fill out to rent a unit and to the forms that a renter has to fill out and send to the owner. This was done to make it easier for owners and renters in two geographic separate places to easily get the forms they need. Once an owner has filled out the owner forms and received the renter forms from the renter, the complete set of forms can be sent to the Briny Breezes office. Last but not least, please remember all forms must be correctly completed and turned in 30 days prior to the date of the renter arriving and the lease beginning.

## **NEWS FROM TOWN HALL**

The Palm Beach County Library's bookmobile is adding the Town of Briny Breezes as one of their stops starting in May. They will be in Briny Breezes on alternate Fridays starting May 8<sup>th</sup>. The bookmobile makes the entire collection of the Palm Beach County Library available. There have been an amazing number of books borrowed from Briny's library this season, and the bookmobile will open up even more possibilities.

The bookmobile will make its first stop on Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, from 1:45 to 2:15 p.m. and it will return to Briny every two weeks.

The library measures the need for the bookmobile based on the number of items checked out, so check out as many as you want, even if you aren't sure if you'll be able to read them all. The bookmobile arrives chock full of books, including new releases, but you can also make special requests. The librarians will search the whole library system and bring the books when they come back.

If you do not have a library card for the Palm Beach County library system, the bookmobile librarians will help you get one in a snap, just bring your driver's license.

## **REMINDERS FROM THERESA, YOUR MANAGER**

This is a reminder to remember the Briny Rules regarding the pool: 'Persons using diapers may not enter the pool'.

Also, remember to register your golf cart if you have not done so already, and always obey the speed limits and the one way streets. If a golf cart is reported without a decal, you may be subject to a fine.

FORWARDING MAIL – Residents have 3 mail forwarding options:

**Temporary Change of Address:** provides 'piece by piece' forwarding of first class mail and periodicals for a specified period of time, but generally doesn't provide the forwarding of Standard Mail or Package Services Mail.

**Permanent Change of Address:** provides for piece by piece first class mail for 12 months and periodicals for 60 days, but generally does not provide the forwarding of Standard Mail or Package Services Mail. The customer's new address is provided to business mailers upon request through mailer endorsements on a mailpiece.

**Premium Forwarding Service Residential:** provides a single weekly shipment of all mail for a residence via Priority Mail service for a fee. Business mailers receive no change of address information for their customers information for their customers. This is temporary and is offered as an additional option to the free temporary or permanent change of address option. This can be started at retail at your local post office, also has an online application that can be accessed at [usps.com](http://usps.com) – Manage Your Mail – Premium Forwarding Service Residential. The fees can be found at [usps.com/manage/forward.htm](http://usps.com/manage/forward.htm). For questions, call the Internet Customer Care Center: 1-800-344-7779.

VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION.....

- **COMMITTEE SIGN UP SHEETS** ARE IN THE OFFICE, if you wish to participate on a committee for 2015/16 PLEASE SIGN UP NOW.
- OLD PARKING DECALS (including the RED town ordinance sticker) MUST BE REMOVED FROM YOUR CAR IMMEDIATELY. **OCEAN RIDGE POLICE WILL BE ISSUING FINES** AS THESE WERE NO GOOD STARTING MARCH 1<sup>ST</sup>.
- **YOU MUST FORWARD YOUR MAIL IF YOU ARE LEAVING.** NO MAIL WILL BE FORWARDED BY THE OFFICE THIS SUMMER. (details below)
- PLEASE leave your **EMAIL ADDRESS** with the office. EMAIL will be the only way to contact the entire community if there is an EMERGENCY. It is also the easiest and most cost effective way to receive your BUGLE.
- RENTALS – ALL **PAPERWORK MUST BE COMPLETE** AND TURNED IN A MINIMUM OF **30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE START DATE** ON YOUR LEASE AGREEMENT. 30 days PRIOR STARTS when the package is COMPLETE. LATE RENTALS WILL NOT BE APPROVED AND OWNER SUBJECT TO FINE. IF A RENTER COMES TO BRINY TO MOVE IN PRIOR TO RENTAL BEING APPROVED, THEY WILL BE TURNED AWAY.
- ANY RENTER OCCUPYING A UNIT PRIOR TO DATE ON AN **APPROVED** LEASE WILL RESULT IN **OWNER BEING FINED 100\$ PER DAY UP TO 1,000\$.**
- **BEGINNING MAY 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2015, THE OFFICE STAFF WILL NO LONGER BE ABLE TO RETRIEVE YOUR MAIL FROM YOUR MAILBOX.** PLEASE do not ring the bell and ask staff to get items from your box. If you are unable to open the combination lock on your box, PLEASE have your box converted to a KEY LOCK.
- **MAILBOX KEY CONVERSION -** IF you wish to have your mailbox converted to a KEY LOCK (example currently in mailroom RIGHT SIDE – BLUE LANYARD hanging) please place your order with the office ASAP. The conversions for all orders placed will be completed as soon as possible and we would prefer to do these in the summer months as time permits.

**The cost is \$40.00 to convert and you will be given 2 keys.** You can make as many copies of these keys as you wish. They are yours and only yours. IF you lose all of your keys, it will cost \$25.00 to get a new lock put on. Simple and easy, no more difficult combination locks to fuss with.

**PLEASE ORDER NOW**, it will take time to convert, cannot all be done at the beginning of next season.
